AN IMPORTANT AND RARE PRE NUMBERED CHARLES II FIGURED WALNUT DUTCH STRIKING BRACKET CLOCK the case raised on four bun feet beneath a shallow caddy top surmounted by a hinged brass foliate hoop handle above a glazed square door enclosing a 6 3/4" gilt brass dial with winged cherub head spandrels and silvered engraved chapter ring featuring typical half-hour 'cross' divisions enclosing a matted centre with calendar aperture below the XII fronting a double fusee movement with six latched finned pillars and verge escapement Dutch striking on two bells with a large outside countwheel and finely engraved signed backplate within a wheatear border. This clock is featured and illustrated in 'THOMAS TOMPION, at the Dial and Three Crowns' by Jeremy Evans.
