The 6 3/4" gilt brass dial with winged cherub head spandrels and silvered skeletonised chapter ring surrounding a matted centre with calendar aperture below XII, Strike/Not strike lever above fronting a twin fusee movement with five finned knopped pillars and verge escapement striking the hours on a bell and pull repeating the quarters on a nest of four bells; fine tulip-engraved and signed backplate with pierced and engraved apron.
