the well-proportioned case having a caddy top pediment with
pierced sound fret surmounted by three brass ball finials,
matching pierced sound fret to the frieze above a glazed door
flanked by brass-capped turned columns on a slender trunk
with moulded edge door and box base raised on a double
plinth. The 12" gilt brass dial with foliate engraved border
between gilt cherub head spandrels, Roman and Arabic
silvered chapter ring surrounding a matted centre with ringed
winding holes below a calendar aperture and subsidiary
seconds dial fronting a substantial three train weight driven
month duration movement with seven finned latched pillars
and outside countwheel striking the hours on a bell and the
quarters on two bells; the backplate mounted with a bracket
to secure the movement to the backboard - comes with
original brass cased weights and pendulum.
